Permits; Certificates of Fitness & Fire Guard Logs: Daily Hot Work Permits are filed in Site Office. Complete Fire Guard log in field & turn in to the GC/CM daily. Copies of any applicable licenses have been provided to the GC/CM.											
Exits and Stairways - Are free of obstructions or trash.											
Controlled Potential Ignition Sources - Exposed electrical wiring is not present. Sparks, slag, etc. falling below Hot Work level requires either additional fire blankets at work level or Fire Guard below. Ignition sources have been controlled or eliminated.											
Trash Accumulation - Combustibles / flammable materials or storage containers are not within 35ft of Hot Work Activity or 30 ft. of Heaters. If so, have the items been removed or relocated.											
No-Smoking - No Smoking rules are enforced in the affected areas.											
Fire Alarm Pull Stations - Free from damage. If damaged pull stations are discovered - immediately report to the GC/CM.											
Fire Extinguishers - Subcontractor supplied ABC Dry Chemical (or equivalent) Fire Extinguisher placed at HOT WORK SITE. Report used / damaged fire extinguishers and note location on fire guard log.											
Standpipe and Sprinkler System - There are no obstructions to standpipe connections. No visible damage on sprinkler or standpipe systems.
